

SUMMARY OF PROPOSED PURCHASE

Item to be purchased: 2018 Freightliner 122SD tandem axle semi-tractor

Purchase cost: \$113,104.00

Requesting dept.: Motor Vehicle Pool to be used by the Utilities Division to haul bio solids for the land application program.

Budgeted item: Yes

Over/under budget: The motor vehicle fund budget is \$783,315. This purchase is listed as a replacement item and is within the approved budget.

Necessity of purchase: The intent of this purchase is to replace #160 which is used by the Utilities Division. The unit is a 24 year old Mack Superliner Tandem axle tractor with 151,864 miles and 13,226 hours. This unit is used extensively from early spring to late fall to haul bio solids within the county for land application. The current vehicle is becoming undependable and unsafe to drive the cab is worn out along with the front steering axle. Due to the age of the vehicle cab major chassis parts are becoming obsolete.

Bid recommendation: We advertised for a new tandem axle semi-Tractor on Intergovernmental trade Network MITN. Four (4) bids were received and the low bid of \$113,104.00 submitted by Wolverine Truck Group of Mt Clemens is recommended.

Impact if not purchased: If this unit is not purchased the City would suffer a reduction in the land application of bio solids causing a potential storage issue of bio solids during the winter months.
